The title of the Friday evening plenary session is "Social Identity based on Texts and Archeology: the Jews." The speakers are Carol Bakhos of UCLA, Gary Knoppers, Pennsylvania State University, Gabriele Boccaccini of the University of Michigan, and David Rudolph of, MJTA. The title of Carol Bhakos's lecture is "The World of the Rabbis: Fact and/or Fiction." Gary Knoppers will present his fresh perspective on Jews in the Persian period. Gabriele Boccaccini will present his latest research on Jewish identity in the Qumran and "intertestamental" period. And David Rudolph will discuss recent trends in post-supersessionist interpretation of New Testament texts for better understanding the social identity of Jesus-believing Jews in the first century context.

Mark Whitters (Eastern Michigan University; Regional SBL President) will deliver the **Presidential Address**, entitled "Group Identity and Caricatures of the Shechemites" at the Saturday evening banquet.
