The Midwest Region Society of Biblical Literature invites applications for the Graduate Student Paper Competition. The region will present **up to two awards of \$300 each, normally for one paper in Hebrew Scriptures/Ancient Near Eastern Studies and one paper in New Testament/Christian Origins**. The region reserves the right to present less than two awards.

Papers must be no more than twenty-five pages in length (a maximum of fifteen pages of main text, double-spaced, and ten pages of endnotes) and must adhere to the guidelines of *The SBL Handbook of Style*. An abstract of 100 words or less must accompany the submitted paper. Papers that exceed twenty-five pages or otherwise do not comply with these instructions will not be considered. Papers should not have been previously submitted.

The recipients of these awards will be expected to attend the Midwest Region SBL meeting (February 7-9, 2014) and read their papers during appropriate sections. The recipients are encouraged to submit their original papers to the journal *Conversations with the Biblical World: Proceedings of the Eastern Great Lakes Biblical Society and the Midwest Region Society of Biblical Literature*.
