Drawing inspiration from Gerald H. Wilson's *The Editing of the Hebrew Psalter*, this volume explores questions of the formation of the Psalter from the perspective of canonical criticism. Though called "canonical criticism," the study actually employs a number of historically traditional and nontraditional approaches to reading the text including form criticism, historical criticism of individual psalms as well as of the whole Psalter, and redaction criticism.

- Examination of the impact of canonical criticism on the study of the Psalter

She is the author of *Reading from the Beginning: The Shaping of the Hebrew Psalter* (Mercer University Press), *Biblical Hebrew: An Introductory Textbook* and *Introduction to the Psalms: A Song from Ancient Israel* (both from Chalice Press).

W. Dennis Tucker, Jr.

Essential research on the relationship between the Persian empire and the the formation of the book of Psalms

In this latest entry in the Ancient Israel and Its Literature series, W. Dennis Tucker, Jr. examines the role of Persian imperial ideology in the creation of psalms in Book V of the Psalter and in the shaping of the book of Psalms as a whole. Although much research has been conducted on the relationship between Persian empire and the creation of biblical texts, the book of Psalms has been largely absent from this discussion. Tucker seeks to rectify this omission by illustrating that Book constructed a subtle anti-imperial ideology in response to the threats imposed from all empires both past and present.

- Close study of the psalms portrayal of human power to that of Yahweh
- Comparison of Achaemenid propaganda to the ideology found in the psalms
- Evidence drawn from Persian iconography and inscriptions

W. Dennis Tucker, Jr. is Associate Professor of Christian Scriptures and Associate Dean for Academic Affairs at George W. Truett Theological Seminary at Baylor University in Waco, Texas. He is the author of *Jonah: A Handbook on the Hebrew Text* (Baylor University Press) and the co-author of *The Story of Israel: A Biblical Theology* (InterVarsity Press).
