Take an exciting and informative tour of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Historic District on "Sweet Auburn Avenue" and see the MLK Center, Dr. King's birth home and tomb. The Exhibition Hall displays a collection of photographs and memorabilia covering Dr. King's public and private life. You will also pass by Ebenezer Baptist Church, where he preached. Guests will continue with a tour of the Carter Presidential Library. Discover the peace-keeping efforts of Nobel laureate President Jimmy Carter. The Carter Center chronicles the life of the 39th president from his birth in 1924 through the post presidency. The museum has a brand-new look which includes history-making scenes from around the world. New exhibits allow visitors to take a virtual trip around the world with the Carters to work on health and democracy programs and to experience a day in the life of the President.

Re-live the Civil War in both fact and fiction. Atlanta's 100+ year-old Cyclorama painting — 42 feet tall and 358 feet in circumference — is said to be the largest painting in the world. Sit at the center of a sweeping panorama of the Battle of Atlanta, fought on July 22, 1864, during the American Civil War. The presentation is accompanied by music and narration, available in five languages. Next, enjoy a visit to one of Atlanta's most beloved attractions, the Margaret Mitchell House. This is the home she lived in with her husband while writing the world famous book *Gone With the Wind* in 1926. You will also have the opportunity to view an extensive collection of *Gone With The Wind* movie memorabilia. Artifacts on display include movie set design sketches and props, movie scripts, movie posters from a variety of foreign countries, premiere event programs, seats from the Loew's Grand Theater and film footage of the premiere.
