Job Advertisement Data 2021–24

Society of Biblical Literature and American Academy of Religion

Executive Summary

As expected, the number of positions advertised through the <u>AAR-SBL Employment</u> <u>Services</u> changed drastically in the years around the COVID-19 pandemic. However, the 2024 numbers appear to be in line with the declines seen in pre-pandemic data, potentially indicating a larger trend disrupted between 2020 and 2022.

The key findings for these years are below, followed by more complete data analysis. When reviewing this report, note that the data in it represent only the jobs posted with AAR and SBL. While it is a representative sample of the job market, the data does not necessarily reflect all positions in the field, in particular positions outside of North America as well as adjunct positions, which may be locally advertised.

Key Findings

- The number of all positions advertised decreased drastically in AY20 and AY21, as expected due to the COVID-19 pandemic, with AY21 listing the lowest number of postings in our record keeping since 2003. However, the AY22 listings rebounded, setting a seven year high. The total number of positions decreased in AY23 and AY24, with AY23 on par with expectations from pre-COVID-19 years and AY24 with a larger decrease.
- Regarding faculty positions:
 - Tenure-track or tenured positions decreased from 75.4% of faculty postings in AY20 to 71.1% of postings in AY24, compared to a record low of 60% of postings in AY21. On average, between AY21–24, 63.6% of faculty positions were listed as tenure-track or tenured positions.
 - Faculty positions increased after a negative spike in AY21 at only 73.6% of positions posted to 77.7% of positions in AY24.
 - Entry-level positions decreased 25.3% from AY19 to AY24.
 - Mid-level and Upper-level positions remained the same in AY20 and AY24, despite variations in the years between.
 - In AY24, 58.3% of entry-level faculty positions were tenure-track or tenured.
- Only 2.1% of the jobs listed between AY21–24 were less than full-time.

• Out of the 1061 jobs listed between AY21–24, only 11.0% of jobs were listed as visiting appointments. AY21 had the highest percentage of positions listed as visiting positions with 15.0%.

Data Analysis




Figure 1. Number of Positions and Number of Discrete Institutions AY17–24

After remaining steady in AY18 and AY19 at a historic low of 403 postings, the number of postings continued to decrease through AY20 and AY21 reaching a new historic low, followed by a spike reminiscent of AY16 levels in AY22 (<u>Table 1</u>). The number of discrete institutions changed at a similar rate to that of the total number of postings, just over 30% between AY20 and AY24 (Figure 1). The number of positions at public institutions increased 86.6% over the same period, reaching record highs, while the number of positions at private not-for-profit institutions decreased 18.7% (<u>Table 2</u>).

The concentration of positions at Baccalaureate institutions increased from 13% to 18% between AY22 and AY24, while the concentration of Master's institutions remained stable. The concentration of Research institutions increased from 48% to 53%, and Special Focus institutions decreased from 26% to 15%. Positions at special focus institutions reached a ten-year low in 2024, with only 39 postings (<u>Table 3</u>).¹





Figure 2. Position Types, AY17-24

After a steady decline from 2008–2017, faculty positions followed the trajectory of overall positions from 2019–2024. While faculty and fellowship/postdoc positions decreased, Administration, Other Higher Education (e.g., Librarian, Non-faculty Researcher), and Other Industry positions (e.g., K-12 and Publishing) categories saw increases in AY21 (<u>Table 4</u>, Figure 2).

Entry-level and mid-level faculty positions saw a marked decrease since 2019, disregarding the bounce-back in 2022. Upper-level positions were constant in 2020 and 2024, despite historic lows in AY21, notable in comparison to entry-level positions, which decreased 15.2% from 2020 to 2024. (Table 5).

Non-tenure track faculty positions increased from 55 positions in AY20 to 59 positions in AY24. Tenure-track positions rebounded to AY17 levels in AY23, then continued to decrease into AY24 (<u>Table 6</u>).



The annual course load distribution was also drastically affected by COVID-19 (Figure 3). A course load of five to six continues to be the highest; however, there was a decrease of 12.1% in AY24. A course load of three to four increased in AY24 (36.3%), rebounding to a similar proportion of classes as in AY22 (Table 7, 8).

When reviewing data from Tables 9, 10, and 11, it is important to note that this information is not required for employers to list when posting a job. Several employers leave these fields empty.

Fittingly, positions that required or desired Online Course Instruction Experience increased 82.4% during the pandemic but returned to pre-pandemic levels by AY24. The percentage of postings that desired or required a PhD reached a 10 year low at 72.6%. Additionally, the percentage of employers who desire or require Ordination and Religious Affiliation/Commitment decreased (Table 9).A PhD continues to be the most desired and required qualification across position levels. Preferences or requirements for Published Book(s) and/or Monograph(s), Published Journal Article(s), and Interdisciplinary Teaching or Research all increase as the position level increases (Table 10).


While some qualifications are consistently desired or required across institution type, there are significant differences for certain qualifications. The percentage of jobs that

either desire or require the following qualifications is significantly for higher special focus institutions: administrative experience, online course experience, ordination, published books and/or monographs, published journal articles, and religious affiliation (Table 11).

<u>Table 12</u> shows fields of expertise for positions listed with AAR-SBL Employment Services. Employers are allowed to select multiple fields for each posting.

After falling alongside the number of postings in AY21, the number of countries represented in job postings bounced back to prepandemic levels. In AY24, sixteen countries were represented, compared to thirteen in AY20 (Figure 7). In the years represented in figures 4-7, The United States had the greatest number of positions listed at 1,131 with Canada and Great Britain following with ninety-two and twenty positions, respectively.

Figure 4. Positions by Country AY21








Figure 6. Positions by Country AY23




Figure 7. Positions by Country AY24


