

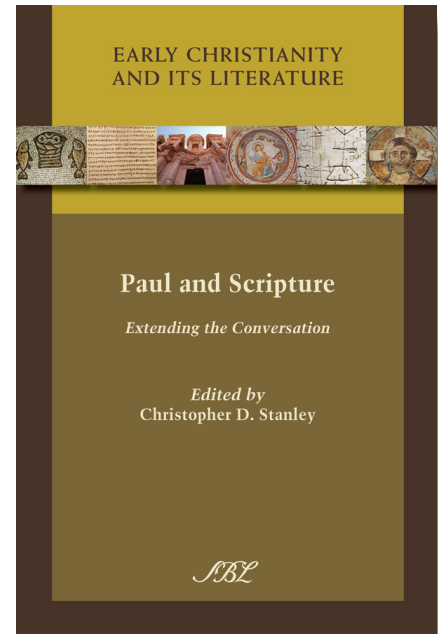


## Paul and Scripture Extending the Conversation

Edited by Christopher D. Stanley

This book explores some of the methodological problems that have arisen during the last few decades of scholarly research on the apostle Paul's engagement with his ancestral Scriptures. Essays explore the historical backgrounds of Paul's interpretive practices, the question of Paul's "faithfulness" to the context of his biblical references, the presence of Scripture in letters other than the *Hauptbriefe*, and the role of Scripture in Paul's theology. All of the essays look at old questions through new lenses in an effort to break through scholarly impasses and advance the debate in new directions.

**Christopher D. Stanley** is Professor of Theology at St. Bonaventure University. He is the author of *Arguing with Scripture: The Rhetoric of Quotations in the Letters of Paul* (T&T Clark) and *The Hebrew Bible: A Comparative Approach* (Fortress) and the co-editor of *As It Is Written: Studying Paul's Use of Scripture* (Society of Biblical Literature), among other works.
